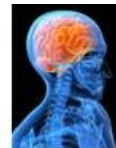

Vocabulary--en el museo de arte

los/las artistas = artists
 los visitantes = visitors
 los cuadros = paintings
 las exposiciones = exhibitions
 las galerías = galleries
 los murales = murals
 las obras = works of art/theatre



Vocabulary—en el teatro

el actor/la actriz = actor/actress
 el bailarín/la bailarina = dancer
 el/la cantante = singer
 el ensayo = rehearsal
 aplaudir = to applaud
 gozar = to enjoy
 gritar = to shout
 bostezar = to yawn



Vocabulary—los instrumentos

el clarinete = clarinet
 la flauta = flute
 el saxofón = saxophone
 el tambor = drum
 el trombón = trombone
 la trompeta = trumpet
 la tuba = tuba
 el violín = violin



Vocabulary—en el cine

la entrada = ticket
 la boletería = ticket (box) office
 la cartelera = the marquee or poster
 la butaca = theater seat
 la cafetería del cine = concession stand
 la pantalla = screen
 la película = movie/film
 el dulce = candy
 las palomitas = popcorn
 el refresco = beverage



Grammar—Gustar (8.04)

Gustar means something is pleasing:

me gusta = it pleases me
 te gusta = it pleases you
 le gusta = it pleases him/her/you (formal)
 nos gusta = it pleases us
 les gusta = it pleases them or all of you

* If more than one thing is pleasing, use gustan.

Me gusta la hamburguesa. = I like the hamburger.
 Me gustan las papas fritas. = I like french fries.
 A Juan le gusta jugar el fútbol. = Juan likes to play soccer.
 A Ana y yo nos gustan los deportes. = Ana and I like sports.

Grammar—Future Tense (8.05)

hablaré	hablaremos
hablarás	hablaréis
hablará	hablarán

*These verb endings work for -ar, -er, and -ir verbs.

*Add the verb endings to the infinitive (do not drop the -ar, -er, -ir).

See 8.06 for the irregular future tense verbs!
